Before use, carefully read and observe the warning texts on the label!

Application:

- Bring can to room temperature.Operating temperature 15 to 25°C
- Shake can for 2 minutes before use.
- Apply silicone spray in a thin layer.
- Best lubrication once the solvent has evaporated (ca. 1 minute)
- Apply a thin even coat and spread with a soft cloth for a brilliant shine.
- · Leave to work for a minute and then polish.
